First Round - Class 4 - 2' Class 5 - 2'6
Second Round - Class 6 - 2' Class 7 - 2'6
Overall Champion - Class 8
Entry Fee \$100

Open to riders accumulating at least 3 points in a Horse & Hound Medal qualifying class since the 2024 Finals.

To be shown over two rounds of approx. 8 fences (Small/Medium to jump 2' & Large to jump 2'6). Round 2 will include 2 tests as part of the course. First round is a drawn order by qualifiers; Second round comes back in reverse score order low to high, and all qualifiers will ride both rounds and ribbons 1st thru 8th will be awarded at the completion of each round.

The top 8 scores overall will ride for awards & ribbons. Two judges will be used and scores announced after each round. Scores from both rounds will be averaged for a final score.

Any rider(s) within 3 points of the top score will be required to work off. Work off, if any, to be determined by the judges.

(Round 1 - Sm/Med will jump first; Round 2 - Large will jump first).

# 25th Annual Horse & Hound Jr/Am Medal Finals

First Round - Class 1 Second Round - Class 2 Overall Champion - Class 3 Entry Fee \$100

Open to riders accumulating at least 5 points in a Horse & Hound Medal qualifying class since the 2024 Finals.

To be shown over two rounds of fences 3' in height. Round 2 will include 2 tests as part of the course. First round is a drawn order by qualifiers; Second round comes back in reverse score order low to high, and all qualifiers will ride both rounds and ribbons 1st thru 8th will be awarded at the completion of each round.

The top 8 scores overall will ride for awards & ribbons. Two judges will be used and scores announced after each round. Scores from both rounds will be averaged for a final score. Any rider(s) within 3 points of the top score will be required to work off. Work off, if any, to be determined by the judges.

### **USHJA National Hunter Derby**

Open to Riders, Owners, and Trainers that are current Active members of USEF and USHJA. Horses and ponies must be registered with USHJA to participate in this class. To be shown over a course of at 3' and will include four (4) high option fences set at 3'5". Prize money and ribbons to 12th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-13%, 4th-8%, 5th-6%, 6th-5%, 7th-4%, 8th-3%, 9th- 3%, 10th-2%, 11th-2%, 12th-2%.

The USHJA National Hunter Derby will be conducted as a two round class. Please see USHJA.org for the USHJA National Hunter Derby Specifications.



## FoxFarms Jr/Am Hunter Derby

Open to non pros. A rider and/or horse may compete in both the Jr/Am Hunter Derby & USHJA National Hunter Derby. To be judge at three different heights, 2'9, 3' & 3'3, a horse and rider combination can only ride in one of the heights. The first phase will be a Classic round consisting of 5-6 fences then directly after the completion of the Classic phase, the horses will pass through a set of markers to begin the Handy phase which will consist of 4-5 fences, where pace, brilliance, and a shorter track are to be rewarded. Option fences may be used in either round. Riders score from the Classic phase will be averaged with the Handy phases to determine the overall winner. In the case of a tie Judge One will be the tie breaker. Prize money and ribbons to 8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.

## Outreach Jr/Am Derby Challenge

Open to non pros. Open to Junior/Amateur riders that have not shown over 2'9 at this competition. A rider and/or horse may not compete in the Jr/Am Hunter Derby or the USHJA National Derby at this show. Same specification as FoxFarms Jr/Am Derby.

### **Autumn Classic Grand Prix**

MURIETA AUTUMN CLASSIC

The Autumn Classic Grand Prix to be scored under Table II, Section 2b. Fences to be set at 1.25m to 1.30m with a minimum of three obstacles in which the spread exceeds the height by 5 cm (2") up to 15 cm (6"). Prize money and ribbons to 8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.

#### **Hunter Sections**

Hunter Sections must have at least 3 judged in 2 over fence classes & the under saddle, for a Show Champion to be awarded.

#### **Equitation Sections**

Equitation Sections must have at least 3 judged in 2 over fence classes & the flat, for a Show Champion to be awarded.

#### **Jumper Sections**

Jumper Sections must have at least 3 judged in at least 3 classes, for a Show Champion to be awarded. Champonship points - 1st-10 points, 2nd-6 points, 3rd-4 points, 4th-2 points, 5th-1 points, 6th-1/2 point. In case of a Championship Tie, Bonus Points in the Last class will be applied; 1st-15 points, 2nd-9 points, 3rd-6 points, 4th-3 points, 5th-2 points, 6th-1 point.

## **JUMPER SECTIONS**

Jumpers: In all jumper classes, ties involving first place will be jumped off. Ties not involving first place will be broken by the fastest time. Orders will be drawn per USEF JP112. Time allowed to be based on a minimum speed of 382 yards per minute for all jumper Sections. Sweaters or Shirts with a collar will be acceptable. Prize to 1st, Ribbons 1st-8th; prize money split 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%. Jumper Welcome & Classic Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-16%, 4th-12%, 5th-10%, 6th-10%. See Rule 38-Featured Jumper Class

A. **RULES AND REGULATIONS:** I hereby agree that I have read, understand, and agree to be bound by all applicable Federation Bylaws, rules, and policies including the USEF Safe Sport Policy and Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies (MAAPP) as published at www.usef.org, as amended from time to time.

#### **RULES AND GENERAL INFORMATION**

- 1. EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.
- 2. MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes
- 3. **FEDERATION ENTRY AGREEMENT**: By entering a Federation-licensed Competition and signing this entry blank as the Owner, Lessee, Trainer, Manager, Agent, Coach, Driver, Rider, Handler, Vaulter or Longeur and on behalf of myself and my principals, representatives, employees and agents, I agree that I am subject to the Bylaws and Rules of The United States Equestrian Federation, Inc. (the "Federation") and the local rules of Murieta Autumn Classic (Competition). I agree to be bound by the Bylaws and Rules of the Federation and of the competition. I will accept as final the decision of the Hearing Committee on any question arising under the Rules, and agree to release and hold harmless the competition, the Federation, their officials, directors and employees for any action taken under the Rules. I represent that I am eligible to enter and/or participate under the Rules, and every horse I am entering is eligible as entered. I also agree that as a condition of and in consideration of acceptance of entry, the Federation and/or the Competition may use or assign photographs, videos, audios, cable - casts, broadcasts, internet, film, new media or other likenesses of me and my horse taken during the course of the competition for the promotion, coverage or benefit of the competition, sport, or the Federation. Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State.
  - The competition and its management agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the PCHA, its directors, officer, committee members, agents and employees from and against all loss or damage including any and all claims arising out of the competition, including claims as to personal injury or property loss or damage suffered during or in conjunction with the competition, whether or not such injury or loss resulted directly or indirectly from negligent acts or omissions of said directors, officers, committee members, agents or employees.
- 4. MANAGEMENT: The Horse Show Management reserves the right to itself to interpret all questions and conditions in regards to, or arising out of, or incident to the show without claims for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions not covered in these Rules and Regulations shall be decided by the Horse Show Management; its decision to be final.
- 5. RESPONSIBILITY: The Horse Show Management reserves to itself the right to refuse, accept conditionally, or to cancel any entries, disqualify any Riders or Competitors, prohibit exhibition of entries, and cancel award prizes, without claim for damages; to change any course, to add a dotted line, to cancel or combine any unfilled classes, or to reschedule classes, after due notice to Competitors; to change rings or rotate judges; to change specifications in Jumper classes as competition warrants and in compliance with all Federation rules.
- 6. CONDITION OF ENTRY: Every horse entered herein for competition will be under the control of the Horse Show Management, but the show management will in no case be responsible for any loss or damage that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each Competitor shall hold the individual horse shows and the officials, employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities, Federation, the Competition, FoxFarms Inc, Murieta Equestrian Center and Cosumnes Corp., and its employees, directors, officers, sponsoring entities of each horse show and the facilities at which each horse show is held blameless for any loss or accident to his horse(s), employee(s), or equipment which may occur from sickness, fire or other cause. All owners and Competitors shall be responsible for any damage incurred by them, their agents or employees to stalls, buildings, and other properties on the show grounds, and shall be billed accordingly.

7. **STALLS:** Stall may be split between two horses for an additional \$150 fee (unable to split discounted stalls). **Trainers will be responsible for payment of all horse & tack stalls requested after entries due date. See Rule 11 for substituting a horse.** An open check or credit card authorization form is required to hold stalls. The Show Office handles all stall transactions and charges. Private transactions involving stalls are not permitted. Request for stalls for horses not entered in the show or for tack, feed or grooming may be reduced by management and refunds given. NO STRAW ALLOWED. Wood or Canvas construction: Top & bottom doors size stalls are 10 x 10, 10 X 12, 12 X 12 most with rubber matts. Anyone dismantling stalls or causing damage to a stall(s) will be charged a \$100 fee per panel, with a maximum fine of \$400 per stall. Outreach Tack Stalls will be \$250. These Tack Stalls only apply to those Trainer/Riders only entered in the Outreach Show.

#### Curfew and quiet times must be observed between 9pm and 5am (as required by GR1215.3 #033-22)

- 8. ENTRY PROCEDURES: Entry blanks must be filled out completely, including all classes entered, COVID-19 and EHV materials, signatures and organizational membership numbers. Entry blanks must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, September 16, 2025 to receive Early Stall/Tack discount. After Tuesday, September 23, 2025, Post Entries are accepted. For each horse entered, a check or credit card for a deposit of \$200 must be included. Numbers will not be issued without a check or credit card covering the balance of the entries.
  - Credit cards (Visa, Master Card, Discover and American Express): Card holder will be charged an additional 3.5% over the published rates as the rates shown in the Prize List are discounted for paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by credit card, upon receipt of the entry blank, and/or credit card authorization form, Horse Show Management will charge the credit card for the Competition registration fees. Credit cards shall be presented to Horse Show Management in the office before or at the time of close out. If such card is not presented or an alternative method of payment is not made, Rider/Trainer/Owner agrees that Horse Show Management is authorized to charge the credit card pursuant to the information contained in the entry blank at the conclusion of the Competition.
  - Cash, Check or Money Order Payments: The rates in this Prize List reflect the 3.5% discount if paying by cash, check or money order. If paying by check, cash, or money order please submit the required payment, made payable to FoxFarms, Inc., with a complete entry blank for each showing or non-showing entry, on or by the published Entries Due.
- NOMINATION FEE & ADD/SCRATCH POLICY: Nomination Fee allows unlimited Adds/Scratches except for Featured Classes (see Rule 38) and astrid (\*\*) marked Hunter Divisions (see rule 13D). Same day Adds/Scratches must be done Online, Add/Scratch Form, or Trainer Form in the Horse Show Office.
- 10. OPEN ARENA FEE: Allows Competitors to ride in the arenas the day before the show as arenas are available and after the show until 6pm as available. See Rule 39 for arena lights. Jumper ring closes 1 hour before start, and hunters 30 to 45 minutes before start.
- 11. **HORSE SUBSTITUTION/SCRATCH POLICY:** After Entries Due substituting a scratched horse with another horse within the same Trainer's barn is allowed, the substituted horse will pay a substitution fee of \$35 in addition to all other fees. The scratched horse will pay the office fee of \$75. Horses scratching the show after the entries due will pay a scratch fee of \$375. Horses scratched at the show will pay \$475 fee unless substituting a horse.

#### ALL SUBSTITUTION MUST BE DONE BEFORE THE START OF THE SHOW.

- 12. **ENTRY BLANKS:** Care should be taken to enter each horse in its proper division or class. Competitors are responsible for their errors and those of their agents completing entry blanks. In all cases the description on the entry blank must fully identify the horse. The word "entry" shall not be accepted.
  - A. Be properly signed, and in the case of a minor, be signed by a parent or quardian.
  - B. Be made on an entry blank provided by the show.
  - C. Show the correct mailing address of the Owner, Trainer and Rider. Changes made after the completion of the show will be charged a Change Fee of \$50.
  - D. Social Security number must be included on entry blank, if not prize money will not be issued.
  - E. Include USEF membership number for each Owner. Lessee, Agent, Trainer and Rider.
  - F. Safe Sport must be complete, if 18 & Over.
  - G. Include USHJA membership number or pay \$30 show pass for each Owner, Lessee, Agent, Trainer & Rider.
  - H.Include all additional membership numbers and birth dates of Junior and Amateur riders.
  - I. All Junior Hunters, Pony Hunters, Children's Pony Hunters and Pony Jumpers must have a USEF measurement card.
  - J. Include Microchip number on the entry blank.
  - K. A show deposit of \$200 per horse must be included with entry.
  - L. Include signed COVID-19 and EHV Release and Protocol's by rider, parent, trainer and groom as required.
  - M. Entries received at the show a rush fee of \$50 may be applied.

- 13. **REFUND POLICY:** All refund requests must be submitted in writing.
  - A. Before entries due, Tuesday, September 23, 2025, all paid fees will be credited or refunded.
  - B. After entries due, the RV deposit will not be refunded. Horses scratching the show after the entries due will pay a scratch fee of \$375. Horses scratched at the show will pay \$475 fee. (See Rule 11). Outreach Horses scratching after the entries due will pay \$200.
  - C After the first class is completed in a astrid (\*\*) marked Hunter Division no refunds will be issued.
  - D. After entries due, no refunds will be given unless you meet one of the following:
  - After the show starts, if a Competitor is ill or injured and cannot compete in the balance of the classes, that Competitor will be entitled to a refund of unused class fees provided the classes are officially scratched and a doctor's certificate is provided to the Horse Show Office prior to the close of the show.
  - After the show starts, if a horse is ill or injured classes scratched the same day they are scheduled receive a refund with an Official Show Veterinarian Certificate provided to the Horse Show Office prior to the close of the show.
  - E. No request for refunds will be accepted after the close of the show.
- 14. **RETURNED CHECKS:** Checks returned by the bank for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be handled in the following procedure. 10% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CHECK WILL BE ASSESSED FOR EACH RETURNED CHECK OR MINIMUM OF \$50. Accounts will be given ten days to be paid in full with cash, or cash equivalent or they will be turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action.
- 15. CREDIT CARD CHARGEBACK: Chargebacks for any reason are regarded as a most serious offense and will be immediately turned into USEF and PCHA for further disciplinary action. 20% OF THE AMOUNT OF THE CREDIT CARD CHARGE WILL BE ASSESSED OR MINIMUM OF \$300.
- 16. UNPAID CHARGES: If the Show Management or Show Official (i.e. farrier, veterinarian, feed supplier, photographer, food concessionaire, etc.) must bill a Competitor/Owner for unpaid charges, a \$50 billing fee will be added to the amount due.
  - A. **Past unpaid balances** Competitor/Owner will be notified of any previous balance at the time of check-in. Outstanding balances must be paid prior to picking up show numbers. Horse Show Management reserves the right to require a deposit paid to cover all show expenses and any portion of the deposit that is unused will be mailed to the addressee on file no later than 15 days after the close of the show.
  - B. **Unpaid Balances** Competitor/Owner who do not come into the office to close out by 5pm at the end of the show forfeit the right to adjustments on any show charges. Final balances will be automatically charged to the payment method on file.
- 17. **PRIZE MONEY**: Prize money will not be deducted from the show bill, prize money will be made payable to the Payee or Owner listed if indicated on the Entry blank and mailed within 30 days after the show.
  - PRIZE MONEY WILL NOT BE MAILED UNLESS THE OWNER OR PAYEE'S SOCIAL SECURITY/TAX ID NUMBER IS LISTED
    ON THE ENTRY BLANK. REQUESTS MADE WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL INCUR A 10% PROCESSING FEE
    TO BE DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY. ALL CHECKS REQUESTED 60 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW WILL RECEIVE A
    CREDIT FOR A FUTURE SHOW. CHECKS NOT CASHED WITHIN 90 DAYS AFTER THE SHOW MAY FORFEIT ALL PRIZE
    MONFY.
  - ANY RETURNED PRIZE MONEY CHECKS DUE TO INCORRECT ADDRESS ON ENTRY BLANK A \$125 WILL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE PRIZE MONEY.
  - REOUESTING 1099 CHANGES AFTER THEY HAVE BEEN MAILED WILL BE CHARGED \$125 TO BE PAID IN ADVANCE.

PRIZE MONEY WON BY FOREIGN COMPETITORS: Foreign competitors are advised that the U.S. Internal Revenue Service requires sporting events to with hold 30% of prize money won in the United States. Foreign competitors should apply for a U.S. Social Security number and will be asked to complete form W-8BEN prior to the Show (FoxFarms, Inc.) issuing prize money won.

#### Altering Prize Money - See Rule 54.

- 18. ADD-BACK: In classes with add-back, prize money is computed from the number of horses that actually show.
- 19. ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE: Horses arriving and/or departing before and/or after these dates & times will be billed \$50 per day per horse.

Arrive no earlier than Monday, 12pm October 13, 2025, Depart by 7pm Sunday, October 19, 2025.

- 20. **PARKING:** Horse trailers will be parked in designated areas. Autos will also be parked in designated areas. There will be no autos allowed in the barn area and aisles.
- 21. RV's: Weekly rate of \$400 30amps, \$450 50amps, \$500 30amps, w/sewer, please book your RV space at www.murietaautumnclassic.com, if cancelled before the entries due date a credit will be provided for current or future show. The RV deposit of \$125 is non-refundable after entries due date. RV'S ARRIVING WITHOUT A RESERVATION WILL PAY AN ADDITIONAL \$100 OVER THE WEEKLY RATE, AS SPACE ALLOWS. RV'S arriving and/or departing before and/or after the scheduled dates & times will be billed a minimum of \$50 per day. See Rule 19.
- 22. **FEED AND BEDDING:** All orders must be made through the Horse Show Office (916) 305-8898.
- 23. **MEDICAL WASTE:** Needles must be placed in the proper receptacles. Anyone found in violation shall be subject to a fine or other penalties deemed necessary by Show Management.
- 24. **MEASURING OF ENTRIES:** Time of measuring will be posted in the Horse Show Office. ALL HUNTER AND JUMPER PONIES AND JUNIOR HUNTERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF OR THEIR ORIGINAL MEASUREMENT CARDS PRESENTED TO ONE OF THE SHOW SECRETARIES OR BE MEASURED IF THE CARD IS NOT AVAILABLE, BEFORE THE COMPETITORS' NUMBER WILL BE RELEASED.
- 25. MOTORIZED VEHICLES: USEF GR1301.7 Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/ legal quardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- 26. **NUMBERS:** Management will provide a number card for each Horse. Horses are now required to have a back number attached to their neck or their rider when outside of their barn/portable stall (as per HJ106.2 #247-22). Riders wearing the wrong number or no number at all may be eliminated from the class by the judge.
- 27. **COURSES:** Courses may consist of any combination of the following: Brush, Gate, Oxers, Panels, Post & Rails, Banks, Ditches, Coups, Logs, Barrels & Liverpools. The horse show management reserves the right to adjust fence heights or spreads in jumper classes as competition warrants.
- 28. POLING: Not allowed in California.
- 29. HARD HATS: USEF GR801.2 It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly \ fitted with harness secured. Exception: In Hunter or Jumper classes, adults may be allowed to remove their headgear while accepting prizes and during the playing of the National Anthem only; they must refasten their headgear prior to the lap of honor. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials)/SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar any entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience.
- 30. SAFETY: Accidents involving Competitors. GR849. In the event of a head injury due to a fall/accident at a licensed competition, the Competitor may be prohibited from further competition until released by medical personnel. In some cases, the Competitor may not return to competition without a signed release from a licensed medical professional. The Competitor may be placed on suspension by USEF until this criteria is met. Competitors are advised to familiarize themselves with this new rule.

- 31.**DOGS:** USEF GR1301.6 Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be held on a leash or otherwise restrained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses, or actions resulting from their dogs' behaviors. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule will be issued a Yellow warning card and may be subject to penalty under Chapter 7. Management reserves the right to call Animal Control to have an animal removed from the premises.
- 32. **SCHOOLING SUPERVISION:** Please be advised that paddock stewards are schooling supervisors and have absolute authority to scratch riders who do not follow USEF schooling rules. They can scratch riders without going through the USEF Steward or the Horse Show Manager.
- 33.TIME SCHEDULE/POSTED ORDER: Each day by 7pm the next day's time schedule will be available on www.horseshowing.com. This time schedule and/or posted orders will be strictly adhered to. The Trainer, Competitor or other representative must tell the paddock steward of possible ring conflicts so that arrangements can be made to accommodate the rider as well as the time schedule. All management decisions will be final. Order of go will be drawn according to USEF Rule JP111.2.
- 34. **ARENAS:** All show and warm-up arenas consist of GGT footing.

  Jumper 1 120' X 240' Hunter 1 105' X 240' Hunter 2 105' X 240' Hunter 3 105' X 240'
- 35. **HAUL INS:** A \$50 haul-in fee per horse per day will be allowed if the entry is received on or before "Entry Due Date" with a payment on file. After Entry Due Date only stalls will be available, unless approved by Show Management. Horses coming from VS Affected Counties will not be able to haul-in, will require a stall and will be required to meet VS Show Protocols which can be found at: www.murietaautumnclassic.com.
- 36.NON SHOWING POLICY: For any horse on the grounds not officially entered, Owner or Trainer of said horse must complete an entry blank and write in the in the area of the Entry Blank used for classes "Non-Showing" and sign the entry blank at the Horse Show Office, pay a \$175 Non Showing Fee, EMT Fee, Stall Fee, and Enviormental Fee. Horses are now required to have a back number attached to their neck or their rider when outside of their barn/portable stall (as per HJ106.2 #247-22).
- 37. 2025 ZONE 10 SPECIFICATIONS: Please see USHJA.org for current class specification with regards to; Children's Hunters, Adult Amateur Hunters, Pre-Green Hunter, Low Children's Jumpers, Low Adult Amateur Jumpers, Children's/Adult Amateur Jumpers, Classics.

#### 38. FEATURED JUMPER & HUNTER CLASSES:

- Horses entering the same day may be required to go first.
- Featured Classes added the same day will pay an additional post entry fee of \$50.
- Featured Classes may only be scratched the day prior.
- Featured Junior/Amateur Jumper Classics are part of the Section Show Championship. If entering just the Classic there is an additional fee of \$50.
- 39. **ARENA LIGHTS:** Lights will be on in the GGT Arena & Stable Mix Arena by 6am at the earlist or two hours (2) prior to the start of the show each day.
- 40. **HUNTER CLASSES:** Requiring a jog will trot a circle at the end of their round on a loose rein.
- 41. **OPEN HUNTER CLASSIC:** This is a two round hunter classic open to Green Hunters, 3', 3'3, 3'6, 3'9, High Performance Hunters, Performance Hunters 3'3 & 3'6. See USEF.org, Rule HU173.
- 42. **HUNTER CLASSICS:** Hunter Classics are two rounds. The last class of the division is the first round of the Hunter Classic.
- 43. **TRAINER SPLITS:** This service allows Trainers to split the show charges for miscellaneous items to their clients. Splits will be accepted until 5pm Friday any splits after Friday will subject to a \$5 office charge per entry. Only items billed by the horse show will be split. Splits will revert back to the trainer for payment if uncollected. FEED & BEDDING ORDERS AFTER 5pm FRIDAY WILL NOT BE INCLUDED IN THE SPLIT AND WILL BE BILLED TO THE TRAINER.
- 44. **PRIZES/RIBBONS/PRIZE MONEY:** Classes awarding prize money & prizes must have at least three entries that complete the course in order to receive prize money & prize, unless otherwise specified by USEF rules. Prize to 1st place, Ribbons 1st 8th. Hunter Prize Money 1st-30%, 2nd-22%, 3rd-15%, 4th-10%, 5th-7%, 6th-6%, 7th-5%, 8th-5%.
- 45.**AWARDS PRESENTATIONS:** In all Featured Classes, an awards presentation will be made and required to ride for awards. Riders failing to present themselves for award presentations will forfeit all prize money. Prize to First Place, Ribbons through eighth place except where otherwise noted.
- 46. FACILITY ENVIRONMENTAL/MANURE REMOVAL FEE: All horses entered in the show must pay a \$50 Murieta Equestrian Center Environmental/Manure Removal Fee.

- 47. COVID-19: All Competitors, Trainers, Staff and additional personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and Sacramento County, requirements and guidelines as they relate to COVID-19 and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.northernwinterclassics.com.
- 48. **EQUINE VACCINATION RULE GR845:** At Federation licensed competitions horses, more than 7 months of age, entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations within six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by Competition Management. See USEF.org for outline of documentation required.
- 49. Equine Herpes Virus (EHV) & Vesicular Stomatitis (VS): All Competitors, Trainers, Owners, Staff and additional Personal are required to adhere to ALL USEF, Murieta Equestrian Center, FoxFarms Inc. and California State requirements and guidelines as they relate to EHV, VS and or the protection of everyone on the showgrounds. All waivers and forms must be completed before entering the show grounds, forms can be accessed at www.murietaautumnclassic.com. Management may impose a Biosecurity fee.

- 50.**SAFE SPORT STATEMENT:** Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement, to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.
- 51.OUTREACH SHOW FEE: Allows Competitors to ride in the arenas the day before the show as arenas are available and after the show until 6pm as available. See Rule 39 for arena lights. Jumper ring closes 1 hour before start, and hunters 30 to 45 minutes before start. Emergency Medical Technician and Office processing.
- 52. SAFETY & WELFARE: All horses must pay a \$55 EMT Standby Fee.




